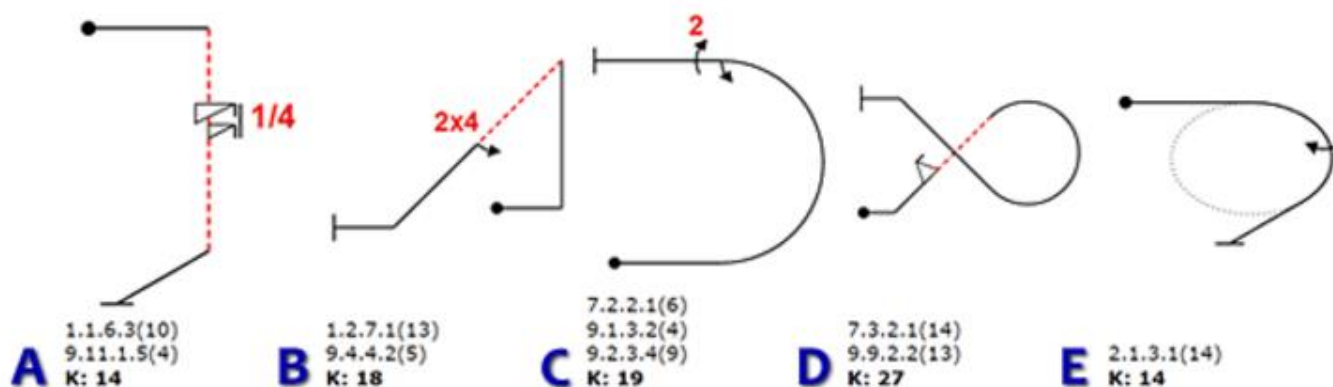

The sequence must comprise TEN figures – no more and no less.		
The FIVE Intermediate/Yak52 “Known” figures for 2016 must be clearly identified, and used without change from the CIVA 2016 published format; see below.		
The FIVE “Free” figures added by the competitor must be clearly identified and the whole sequence must in every respect comply with Section-6 part-1 regulations.		
No repetition of catalogue numbers is allowed.		
The Form-A Catalogue numbers must be correct versus Form B, or L versus R.		
Form A matches Form B , Form B matches Form C, or Form L matches Form R.		
The maximum Total K allowed = 200.
